Firewise News

Happy New Year Ridgewood!

Our hearts and prayers go out to the victims and their families who have been impacted by the LA wildfires.

The LA wildfires have caused me to pause and emphasize the **REAL RISK OF A WILDFIRE IN RIDGEWOOD!**

The RNA website, <https://ridgewoodsonora.org/>, has information and links for resources and tools to educate the importance of individual property wildfire mitigation and to help guide you on what you can do, on your own, to make your property and surrounding properties fire safe.

Available links include: home hardening guidelines, tips from NFPA to protect your home, and defensible space specifically in Zones 0, 1, & 2. These links are a sampling of information, more information is available on the Tuolumne Fire Safe Council website: <https://tuolumnefiresafe.org/>

Time, resources, and personal investments are what will sustain our ability to retain our national recognized Ridgewood 108 Firewise certificate and create a fire resilient community **TOGETHER!**

Paying annual dues and attending the social events can bring many benefits; meeting your neighbors, getting involved in the community, taking advantage of



discounted services for fire mitigation, pest control, tree trimming and skirting, pre-emergent herbicide spraying, and weed whacking to mention a few.

The sheet is a check list of items to think about collecting if you receive a 15-minute warning, a 30-minute warning, a 1-hour warning and a 2-hour+ warning.

May 3, 2025 is a National Wildfire Community Preparedness Day

This day is a campaign that encourages people and organizations everywhere to come together on a single day to take action to raise awareness and reduce wildfire risks. It is held annually in the United States and Canada on the first Saturday in May. Ridgewood 108 Firewise is committed to participating in this very important event in 2025. Community participation will be essential for reporting and renewal of the Ridgewood 108 firewise certificate in 2026.

Each of us can help promote wildfire protection by participating in risk reduction projects on or before the first Saturday in May. Studies show that measures taken at the home and in the area within 100 feet of it, known as the Home Ignition Zone (HIZ), have a significant impact on minimizing damage and loss. Something as simple as clearing the immediate 5-foot zone around the home can assist in making a huge difference in avoiding a catastrophe.

To help our residents in this effort, Ridgewood 108 Firewise together with the RNA is planning an event on **March 9, 2025 at the Moose Lodge from 2:00-4:00pm** to bring residents and potential services together. This will be an opportunity to gauge interest and understand the needs on individual properties to prepare for the May 3rd clean up campaign.

In closing, please save the date of **March 9, 2025** to attend the RNA membership preparation social event. This event will focus on identifying properties that would like to enlist in preparing their properties by contracting services at a discount for tree trimming and skirting, weed whacking, and raking of fallen pine needles and leaves for the May 3rd pick-up and removal.

Neighborhood Watch Information

Neighbors,

The Tuolumne County District Attorney's Office recently announced their specialized DUI Prosecution Unit following the award of a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety in response to the increased need for DUI enforcement in Tuolumne County. In the first quarter, the Unit reviewed a staggering total of 83 DUI cases, 67 of which resulted in convictions.



Our community is smart, conscientious of others, and has the resources available to never excuse making the choice to drive while impaired. We must do better. Plan ahead and designate a sober driver. If this is not an option, taxi and Uber services are both available in Tuolumne County. Call a neighbor, a friend, or a relative. One choice to drive while impaired could change the course of your entire life, and most importantly of anyone who is a victim of your choice.

To report a suspected impaired driver:

- Call 911 (if you have a passenger, please have them call)
- Provide your location, speed, and details about the vehicle
- Stay far away from the vehicle
- Most importantly: keep yourself safe

For all emergencies, always dial 911.

For non-emergencies, contact the Tuolumne County Sheriff's Office Dispatch at 209- 533-5815.

Dear Ridgewood Neighbors,

J.S. West has again committed to serve the residents of Ridgewood at a discounted rate for tank leases along with a discounted price per gallon rate for the 2025 calendar year. J.S. West has pledged to provide the residents of Ridgewood with the highest level of service, safety, and reliability.

One of the benefits of RNA membership and living in Ridgewood is our Propane Cooperative Program that is annually negotiated on behalf of our 164 homes to identify the best supplier(s). This information is password protected on the RNA website and is only available to those who are current with their RNA annual dues.

I'm happy to report that there were zero complaints or concerns regarding J.S. West's service in 2024.

<https://www.dgs.ca.gov/PD/Resources/Page-Content/Procurement-Division-Resources-List-Folder/Liquefied-Petroleum-Gas-Fuel-Postings> and select the week your delivery will be made, find the Market Base Rate for TARGA-SF and add to your Supplier's Vender Fee, this is your estimated price per gallon.
